All you have to do is input the business type, postcode, complete a number of standard check boxes, and the web portal generates a bespoke report of suggested loss-mitigation measures.

- The portal has collated risk-control data and statistics specific to postcodes in the UK, including:
 - fire loss statistics and emergency service response times
 - flood data, weather and geographical risk factors
 - theft, vandalism and cyber-crime statistics.
- The tool was developed by RISC Authority (Risk Insight, Strategy and Control Authority) and the Fire Protection Association (FPA).
